



2018 Incygnés Green's Vineyard Grenache Rosé

Barossa Valley, South Australia

Winemaking –The grapes were harvested at night to retain their natural acidity and freshness, then crushed to a fermenter where the juice stayed on skins for 24 hours before being run off into seasoned French oak hogsheads to ferment. Following fermentation, the wine remained in barrel for 12 months allowing the rose to mature and build complexity in the aromas, flavours and texture.

Vineyard Background – The estate grown grapes for this wine were harvested from our 30-year-old Grenache vines planted on our Green's Vineyard. Sitting east of Tanunda, at the foot of the Barossa ranges, the eclectic mix of soils provides the personality for our wines. Planted to Shiraz and Grenache, the Green's Vineyard pays homage to the traditions of the Barossa Valley albeit in a modern way.

Winemaker's Tasting Notes – Showing salmon pink hues, the lifted floral and strawberry aromas are complimented with spicy notes from the barrel fermentation. The palate, with its chalky tannins, has depth and concentration in the mid-palate, and the strawberry flavours that following through give beautiful persistence. This is a great aperitif style drink or a wine that can be enjoyed with light dishes including salads.
